Generations of Faith (GOF)

This format is for all ages and promotes on-going and lifelong formation. **Families attend sessions together.** Families stay together for the entire 2 hour session which includes a meal, lesson and home packet. There is a 45 family maximum for each of these sessions to allow comfortable space for families to work together in the social hall.

Parish School of Religion (PSR)

K—5th grade students attend classes in the classroom setting with two catechists and up to 14 students per class.

6th—8th Grade Edge

Middle school students gather in a large group and break into small activity/discussion groups.

9th-12th Grade Life Teen

Teens gather in large group and break out into small activity/discussion groups.

Maximum Overdrive (MO)

All Confirmed teens are invited to participate in Maximum Overdrive. This group meets on Sunday nights from 6:30 pm —8:00 pm. There is a \$25 fee for Max-O.

Special Needs

Faith formation is available for K-8th grade students who may not be comfortable with or able to learn in a traditional classroom setting. These classes are available on Wednesdays.

Sacramental Preparation

First Communion

To properly prepare for the sacrament, all students must complete two years of faith formation (typically 1st and 2nd grade, but student may be older). In addition to faith formation classes the second year of preparation also includes a take-home packet and several parent/child workshops. Catholic school students must register for First Communion, complete the take-home packet and attend parent/child workshops.

Confirmation

To properly prepare for the sacrament, all students must complete two years of faith formation (typically 9th and 10th grade, but student may be older). Both years of preparation require service hours and retreats, this includes students enrolled in Faith Formation classes as well as Catholic School students.
